- Attend every meeting and participate to the best of your ability
- Only 3 absences are allowed excused or unexcused
- Arrive on time and prepared to participate
- o If you will be more than 5 minutes late, kindly inform the office beforehand
- Participate in mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and complete your passports
- Have the deacon or priest stamp or sign your passport after mass
- Passports should be brought to every class for verification
- Second year candidates must attend the retreat and rehearsal day (see schedule)
